

A CRITICAL REVIEW ON DANTODBHEDAGADANTAKA RASA**Pawar Anuja Samindar¹, Chowta Jithesh²**

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Oral health is a good indicator of overall well-being and quality of life. The mouth is considered a window into the health of the body because it is a gateway to the alimentary canal. Teething is a natural physiology and development stage that all children experience and generally commences from 6 months to 3 years.

A recent literary review showed that the global prevalence of dental caries in primary teeth was 46.2% and for permanent teeth 53.8%.

Aacharya Kashyapa has devised a complete description of *Danta Shaarira*, which is evidenced by the particular chapter *Dantajanmika Adhaya*. He has detailed explanations about *Dantajanma*, *Sakrutajata* and *Dwija danta*, and *danta bheda*.

Dantodbheda gadantaka rasa is an *Ayurvedic* medicine in the tablet form having predominantly *katu-tikta rasa*, *laghu-ruksha guna*, *ushna virya* and *katu Vipaka*. It treats disorders such as *jwara* and *Atisara* during teeth eruption in children.

INTRODUCTION

Aahara is one of the *Upastambha* for maintaining health as it aids *Dantaposhana*. Healthy teeth are essential for a healthy body. *Aacharya Kashyapa* has mentioned detailed description of *Dantabhedha* and its *avstha* in *Dantajanmika Adhayaya*. The two upper teeth are called *Rajdanta* (central incisors), *Vasta* (lateral incisors), *Damshtra* (canines), *Hanvya* (pre-molars and molars) erupt usually between 6 and 10 months of age¹. in chewing. Oral health influences general well-being and quality of life. Oral disease can

be debilitating and is a considerable health issue discussed worldwide. The *Dantodbhed gadantaka rasa* mentioned in *Bhaishjya ratnavali Baalrogadhikara*. It has *katu-tikta rasa*, *laghu-ruksha guna*, *ushna virya*, and *katu vipaka*. It will help in fast eruption of teeth and manage the diseases during *dantjanma* in children³.

DISCUSSION

Dantodbheda gadantaka rasa is an ayurvedic medicine with ingredients like *Pippali*, *Pippalimoola*, *Chitraka*, *Chavya*, *Nagara* etc. Predominantly it has *Katu-tikta* rasa, *Laghu-ruksha* guna, *Ushna* virya, *Katu* vipaka, and mainly *Kapha-vatahara*. *Pippali* and

Pippalimoola contain piperine, B-sitosterol, Cepharedi-ones and essential oil, so it is best digestive and helps to relieve bloating and constipation. *Chavya* has *grahi* property, due to which it relieves diarrhoea and dysentery. *Chitraka* has *katu* rasa and *ushna* virya, a digestive appetiser that balances *vata* and *kapha*. Some of the ingredients like *pippali*, *pippalimoola* contain key

phyto-constituents like piperin, B-Sitosterol, cepharadiones and essential oil which is best digestive and helps to relieve the bloating and constipation.

Nagaa has katu rasa, which is used as a carminative and is helpful in good digestion and fever. *Yavani* seeds are *katu* and *tikta rasa*, acting as carminatives, appetisers, balance *vata*, and *kapha dosha*. *Haridra* has analgesic, anti-bacterial, anti-allergic, and antioxidant properties. *Abhraka bhasma* contains iron, magnesium, potassium, calcium, aluminium, and plant alkaloids, which help treat abdominal and respiratory disorders. So, the combination of *dantodbhed gadantaka rasa* is very beneficial in *jwara*, and *atisara*, which are common in children during teeth eruption²³.

CONCLUSION

Poor oral hygiene is the leading cause of oral diseases, significantly impacting an individual's quality of life. *Dantodbhed gadantakat rasa* has *katu-tikta rasa*, *laghu-ruksha guna*, *ushna virya* and *katu vipaka* and mainly it is *vata kaphashamaka*. Hence, it plays a vital role in the diseases that occur during the *danta utpatti*. The combination of *dantodbheda gadantaka rasa* is beneficial in *jwara*, *atisara* and easy teeth eruption. It has essential elements that play a significant role in many disorders.

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
